## Information about public transport in Berlin

Berlin has a well-organized public transport. The city has a network system of urban railways (S-Bahn), underground lines (U-Bahn), busses and tramways (Tram) to reach every location.

## **Tickets for public Transport**

The network system in Berlin is divided into 3 parts (tariff zones) - A, B or C - dependent from the distance to the city centre. You can see the tariff zone from the network map. For trips inside the city, you usually need an AB-ticket. You can buy tickets from the ticket office, the ticket machine or from the bus driver. Ticket machines are located at all train stations, underground stations, urban railway stations and inside the trams. The ticket machines take both cash and EC cards. Please do not forget to validate your ticket before starting your journey (not necessary for tickets from a bus driver or from a ticket machine in the tram).

The following tickets are available:

Single ticket – tariff zone AB	2.10 €
Single ticket – tariff zone BC	2.50 €
Single ticket – tariff zone ABC	2.80 €

A single ticket is valid for 2 hours. You may change the trains/busses. You can interrupt your travel within the two-hour validity.

4-Trip-ticket – tariff zone AB	8.00€
Day ticket – tariff zone AB	6.10 €
Day ticket – tariff zone BC	6.30 €
Day ticket – tariff zone ABC	6.50 €

A day ticket can be used from the day of validation until 3 a.m. of the following day.

A special tourist ticket is also available. The City TourCard is valid for all public transport for 48 hours or 72 hours for one adult. It is additionally a discount card for approx. 50 tourist attractions. Please validate the ticket before the first trip.

## From Tegel Airport to the Estrel Hotel

It takes approximately 60 min from the Tegel airport to the Estrel Hotel. You need a single ticket, tariff zone AB (2.10 €).

#### Alternative 1

- Take the bus **TXL** (Direction: Mollstr./Prenzlauer Allee) up to the station *S Beusselstraße*.
  - Frequency: Monday to Friday: every 10 min, Sunday every 20 min
- Go to the urban railway station (S-Bahn) and take the train of the circle line ringbahn S41. Leave the train after 12 stations at the station S Sonnenallee. You can see the hotel from the station. Frequency: every 5 to 10 min

#### Alternative 2

- Take the bus X9 (Direction: S+U-Bahn Zoologischer Garten) for two Stations up to the station S+U Jungfernheide.
   Frequency: every 10 to 20 min
- Go to the urban railway station (S-Bahn) and take the train of the circle line ringbahn S42. Leave the train after 14 stations at the station S Sonnenallee. You can see the hotel from the station. Frequency: every 5 to10 min

# From Schönefeld Airport to the Estrel Hotel

It takes approximately 40 min from the Schönefeld airport to the Estrel Hotel. You need a single ticket, tariff zone ABC (2.80 €).

#### Alternative 1 – by bus

 Take the bus 171 (Direction: U-Bahnhof Herrmannstraße) up to the station S Sonnenallee (31 stations). You can see the hotel from the station.

Frequency: every 20 min

#### Alternative 2 – by urban railway line (S-Bahn)

Go to the urban railway station (S-Bahn) S Flughafen Berlin-Schönefeld Bhf (approx. 6 min walking distance) and take the train of the line S9 (Direction: S Spandau). Change the train after 8 stations at the station S Treptower Park to the circle line Ringbahn S41. Leave the train at the next station S Sonnenallee. You can see the hotel from the station. Frequency: every 20 min

# From Tempelhof Airport to the Estrel Hotel

It takes approximately 15 min from the Tempelhof airport to the Estrel Hotel. You need a single ticket, tariff zone AB (2.10 €).

Go to the underground station (U-Bahn) U Platz der Luftbrücke and take the train of the line U6 (Direction: Alt-Mariendorf). Change the train after two stations at the station S+U Tempelhof. Go to the urban railway station (S-Bahn) and take the train of the circle line Ringbahn S42. Leave the train at the third station S Sonnenallee. You can see the hotel from the station.

Frequency: every 20 min
