Roman Kolar is a biologist (Diploma by University of Bochum) and has been working for the Animal Welfare Academy, the scientific affiliation to the German Animal Welfare Federation, since 1994. He is Deputy Director of this Academy and scientific advisor to Eurogroup for Animal Welfare, the umbrella organisation of the major animal welfare associations in the EU. He is representing Eurogroup at various functions at the level of the EU institutions and the Council of Europe. Roman Kolar is member of several national and international committees and bodies that deal with issues of animal experimentation and alternatives, such as the Scientific Advisory Committee of the European Centre for the Validation of Alternative Methods, the Board of the European Consensus-Platform on Alternatives, the committee for the annual Alternatives to Animal Experiments award of the German Government, diverse ethics committees, and others. He is also a Deputy Member of the Council of the German Platform for Alternatives to Animal Experiments (SET) and the Advisory Committee of the German Centre for Documentation and Evaluation of Alternatives to Animal Experiments (ZEBET). In numerous publications and conference presentations he has strived to raise awareness for animal protection in science and research.
