


WHO Surveillance Programme for Control of Foodborne Infections and Intoxications in Europe 7th Report

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1. General information

The Regulations of 29 April 1983 (Article 17) concerning the profession of physicians, dentists and veterinarians require that all physicians practising medicine or dental medicine in Luxembourg notify all cases of infectious or communicable diseases which are subject to compulsory notification. The notifiable diseases list has been compiled by the Minister of Health in May 1983. The Regulations of 21 November 1980 concerning the organization of the Health Administration stipulate in article 4 (2) that the Health Inspection division is in charge of public health protection with respect to environmental hygiene as well as surveillance and prevention of communicable diseases.
